

## What happens when you convert your course

<b>Homepage becomes Course Content Home</b>	<p>The following homepage elements migrate:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- organizer pages</li> <li>- uppers upper and lower textblocks (now, headers and footers)</li> <li>- custom icons</li> <li>- column layout</li> <li>- links to content items</li> </ul>
<b>Organizer Pages becomes Folders</b>	
<b>Link Text &amp; Icons</b>	<p>Content items previously in selective release are migrated as Hidden links. Selective release criteria do not migrate.</p> <p>Links to tools now appear on the course menu under Course Tools.</p> <p>To change the text of most links on your new folder pages (home page), use the <b>Customize Link</b> option instead of Edit Properties. Customize Link is also the only way to change an icon</p> <p>If you had html code in homepage or organizer page links in CE, that code may remain in the title field but will not work in Vista. When you have time, you should remove the html code.</p> <p>If your course utilizes the CE “<b>_COURSEID_</b>” variable in course links, those links will be broken. Fix the links by removing the variable.</p> <p>Note: This sometimes happens in publisher content (e-packs). If you have a lot of links to repair, you may find it easier to start over with a Vista 4 version of your e-pack if one is available.</p> <p>Page display may be set to “Custom Layout” and may appear incorrectly unless you click <b>Customize Page Display</b> and select another option</p>
<b>Assignment tool</b>	<p>Assignments migrate and the Assignments tool appears in the course menu under Course Tools.</p>
<b>Calendar tool</b>	<p>Calendar tool added to the course menu under Course Tools.</p>
<b>CD-ROM utility</b>	<p>Is not being replaced in this installation of WebCT; refer students to CD-ROM based content by guidelines within your course</p>
<b>Chat tool</b>	<p>General purpose rooms migrate and Chat appears in the course menu under Course Tools.</p>

<b>Compile utility</b>	Does not exist in this version of WebCT; however, you can include a Create Printable View button allowing you to create a printable view of compiled content (Calendar, Discussions, Mail, Syllabus, in the Action Menu of Learning Modules and more).
<b>Course Menu Links</b>	<p>If you had a link to a Single Page (file) on the Course Menu in CE, and this was the only place the file was linked in CE, the link will not appear in Vista. The file, however, will be in the File Manager, waiting for you to create the link somewhere.</p> <p>If you had links to URLs (web pages) on the Course Menu in CE, they will appear in the Web Links tool, in the Vista Course Menu.</p>
<p><b>Content Module tool becomes</b></p> <p><b>Learning Module tool</b></p>	<p>All content modules migrate.</p> <p>The Learning Module tool is added to the course menu, under Course Tools.</p> <p>The following types of links migrate:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Action menu links</li> <li>- Links from an organizer page to a content module</li> <li>- Glossary keyword links in pages of content (however, plural, past-tense and two-line links do not).</li> <li>- Links to files, audio, video, quizzes, self-tests, URLs and glossaries, migrate to links in the Action menu.</li> </ul> <p>Upper/lower textblocks in content modules do not migrate. Information on these pages will need to be created in the form of web pages from Campus Edition</p> <p>If you would like the Table of Contents to be always on the left, you need to select that option in <i>Edit Properties</i> for that learning module.</p>
<b>CSS pages</b>	If you use a single Cascading Style Sheet to serve several pages, the style will not be retained with the <b>Create Printable View</b> option unless you add the full path to the reference to the style sheet in the <head> section of your web pages. To find the full path, see the <b>View File HREF</b> option in the <i>ActionLinks</i> menu for the .css file.
<b>Glossary tool becomes a collection within the Media Library tool</b>	Each keyword in the Glossary migrates to an entry in the Media Library collection "Glossary". Media Library appears under Course Tools.
<b>Grade Book</b>	Custom Grade Book columns do not convert and will need to be recreated in Vista. Assignment and quiz columns are maintained.
<b>Image Database tool becomes a collection</b>	All image databases migrate, becoming collections in Media Library. You can

<b>within the Media Library tool</b>	add links to a specific Media Library collection from a folder or learning module.
<b>Index tool</b>	Does not exist, entries do not migrate.
<b>Language Selector tool</b>	Does not exist. However, you can select course language by choosing Manage Course   Settings   Administration   International.
<b>Mail tool</b>	Mail tool added to the course menu under Course Tools.
<b>Manage files becomes File Manager tool</b>	<p>All folders and files migrate. File Manager added to the course menu under Designer Tools.</p> <p>Your import files will reside under the <b>My Files</b>; you may eventually exceed the maximum size (My Files is separate from your section file space; your My Files area is accessible from any section.) Delete import files when you are through using them so you do not have any surprises the next time you wish to import.</p> <p>If you do not want to leave imported files in the Import Resources folder, you may move files or folders out of Imported Resources without breaking links from folder pages or learning modules.</p>
<b>My Grades tool</b>	The My Grades tool is added to the course menu. From the Student View tab, choose My Tools   My Grades.
<b>My Progress tool</b>	The My Progress tool is added to the course menu. From the Student View tab, choose My Tools   My Progress.
<b>Question Database</b>	All questions and categories migrate to the Questions Database in Assessments.
<b>Quizzes/Surveys tool becomes the Assessments tool</b>	<p>Assessments tool added to the course menu under Course Tools. All quizzes, including questions, migrate. Links from an organizer page to a specific subset of quizzes and surveys migrate to a folder containing links.</p> <p>Upper and lower textblocks in CE quizzes do not convert in Vista; you can put information about the quiz in the description area of the quiz properties</p> <p>Quiz categories will not import by themselves; you must have a quiz in Campus Edition that contains at least one question from a category in order to export the categories. Once you get the exported content into Vista, you can delete the temporary quiz.</p> <p>If you had quizzes selected through the Quiz/Survey tool on an organizer page in CE, the individual quiz or survey will be linked on a folder page in Vista, however you may not be able to move that link using the Move function or through the Power View. Delete the link and re-add it using <b>Add Content Link</b>.</p>

	<p>You can Import quiz questions with <b>duplicate question titles</b> from CE; however, if you need to edit the quiz question in Vista, it will force you to give it a unique title at that point.</p> <p><b>Images</b> – it may not be possible to delete an image that is linked to a quiz question that comes from a Campus Edition</p>
<b>Search utility becomes the Search tool</b>	Search added to the course menu under Course Tools.
<b>Self Test tool becomes a part of the Assessments tool</b>	Assessments tool added to the course menu under Course Tools. All self-tests, including questions and links from organizer pages, migrate.
<b>Single Pages become links on folder pages</b>	Links from an organizer page to a single page migrate. They become files on folder pages
<b>Student Homepages tool becomes an Assignment option</b>	Content from Student Homepages becomes an assignment titled Student Home Page. The Assignments tool is added to the course menu, under Course Tools. Links from organizer pages now go to the Student Home Pages assignment.
<b>Student Presentations tool an Assignment option</b>	Content in the Student Presentations tool becomes a group assignment titled Student Presentations. The Assignments tool is added to the course menu under Course Tools. All group names and descriptions migrate to the new Group Manager tool (see the Teach tab). Links from an organizer page to Student Presentations now go to the Student Presentations assignment.
<b>Student Tips tool</b>	Does not exist. You can use Announcements to send tips to students.
<b>Syllabus Tool</b>	<p>Syllabus data, except course and instructor information, migrates. Syllabus tool is added to the course menu under Course Tools.</p> <p>The Syllabus tool does not automatically appear in Course Tools if you had the syllabus on your CE home page</p>
<b>URL appear where they were linked and also inside the Web Links tool</b>	URLs migrate and the Web Links tool appears under the course menu under Course Tools.
<b>Whiteboard tool becomes a part of</b>	Whiteboard is integrated with Chat. A room named “Whiteboard” is created. The Chat and Whiteboard tool is added to the course menu under Course
